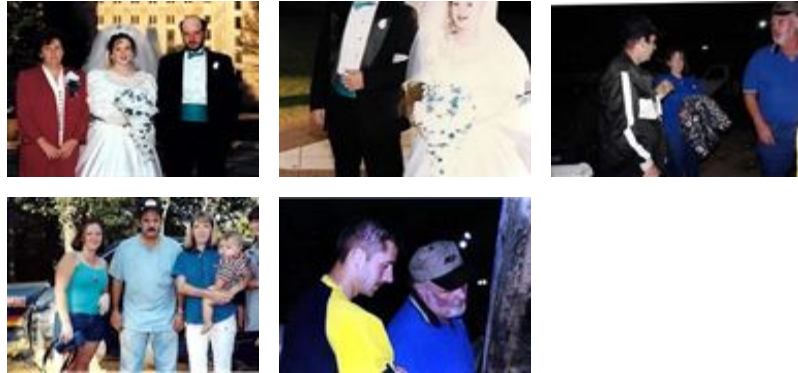


“ *I remember the first time that I MET Fred.

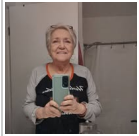
