Rev. L.R. Rasmussen age 79 of Wilsonville, went home to be with the Lord on November 3, 2014.

Rev. Rasmussen pastored 47 years over much of the state. Even after retiring, he took a small church and remained there seven years until his health forced him to resign. His first love was the Lord, then his family, and if you saw him more than once, he considered you family. If he saw a need, he tried to fill it, even if it meant doing without himself. He fought a good fight and he kept the faith. We will miss him greatly, but we shall meet again.
