“ In October 2007, my boys and I were involved in an automobile accident on Corner School Road. Nickole was traveling the same direction on the same road. While many turned around to continue to their destinations, Nickole chose to walk down the hill to see how she could help. She recognized that the paramedics and police had not made it to the scene, and she knew that help was needed immediately.



Since we had attended the same church together, she knew who I was and quickly realized the extent of the wreckage. When Nickole asked how she could help, I told her that my parents could go to Children's with our boys, if she (Nickole) could go tell them. Without any hesitation, Nickole drove to my parents' house to relay the information.

If not for Nickole doing this for us, no one would have been there to accompany my two year olds to Children's. Instead, my parents were able to contact my husband. In turn, my parents accompanied my boys to Children's and my husband accompanied me to St. Vincent's.

I could never thank Nickole enough for being the Good Samaritan I needed that day. Her love, concern, and actions exemplified who she belonged to: God. Nickole was a present day example of the Good Samaritan.

In Luke 10:25-37, the expert of the law tests Jesus by asking how he could inherit eternal life. Jesus replied, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind; and 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'"

Then the expert in the law asked, "And who is my neighbor?" Jesus tells a story of a man who was attacked by robbers, stripped of his clothes, beaten, and left for dead. A priest and a Levite pass on the

*other side. But the Good Samaritan takes pity on him by caring for his wounds, putting the man on his (the Samaritan's) donkey, bringing him to and paying for his stay at an inn, and choosing to care for him until he was well. The expert of the law finally recognizes that "the one who had mercy on him" was the neighbor. To conclude, Jesus commands him to "go and do likewise."*

*In the day and time we live, few choose to be a neighbor by showing mercy to another. Many choose to separate themselves from situations they do not have to be a part of. Our choices do affect others. May we all consider assuming the role of a Good Samaritan and to "go and do likewise" like Nickole did for us that October day.*
