Maxwell Scott Hall, Sr., age 97, of Sumiton, AL, passed away March 16, 2021 at his residence surrounded by his family and friends. Scott was born to O.B. and Roberta Hall, February 2, 1924, in Bessemer, AL. Scott attended Dora School. He married Ellen Louise Bush Hall on December 21, 1949 in Columbus, MS. Scott received special training in the telecommunication field through courses offered by the University of AL. He worked as a Field Engineer for Southern Bell Company for more than 25 years. Scott also owned Hall-Britton Engineering Company. Scott was a Veteran of WWII. He served in the United States Navy on the USS Pennsylvania in the South Pacific. He was awarded nine campaign medals, stars and ribbons, a Unit Citation from the President of the Philippines and a Navy Unit Accommodation Medal from the Secretary of the United States Navy. Scott was a former deacon at the Primitive Baptist Church. He was a farmer and carpenter. Scott was a sports fan but the University of Alabama was his favorite university. He gardened, fished and enjoyed working outdoors until he was around 90 years of age. Scott is preceded in death by his parents, five brothers, five sisters and two grandchildren.
