



## Terry Glover

June 27, 1944 - December 31, 2021

Terry Glover, 77 of the Bagley community, was born June 27, 44 and was reunited with his wife Leslie and son, "Little Jimmy" on Dec. 31, 2021. He was a graduate of Corner High School. He served in the Army National Guard. He began his career in law enforcement in 1969, and ultimately retired as Sargent from the Birmingham Police Department as well as the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department. He attended Dorsey Creek Community Mission Church. He was an avid Auburn football fan.

A Celebration of Life service will be held on Tuesday January 4, 22 at 2:00 pm in the New Horizon Memorial Chapel. Rev. Ted Blalock and Rev. Preston Headrick will officiate. Burial will follow in McCormack Cemetery. Visitation is Tuesday from 12:30- 2:00 pm.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 32 years, Leslie Ann Smith Glover; his son, Terry "Little Jimmy" Glover; his parents, Mama Jean and Daddy Oliver Glover and his grandparents, Celia and Leonard Stanley.

“ I had the blessing of working with Terry at the North Precinct on the Evening shift. We worked with Dwight Lowe, Harry Deal, and Harry Hayes. These guys were fun to be around, and something was always happening. It was never ever boring. On Christmas Eve 1977, I was the lone sergeant working the shift, with four months experience.

An officer asked if he could go off his beat to carry a waitress to her home. She was having hardships many of us knew about, and it was Christmas. I asked him where she lived, he told me Springville. I told him to get with Trussville and see if we could get her to Trussville, would they get her the rest of the way home. The officer told me Trussville would help and I approved him taking her to Trussville. The next two days were my off days. When I returned Terry was waiting for me where I parked my car. He asked if I knew anything about the officer taking the waitress to Springville. I told him about the arrangement with Trussville then Terry told me what really happened. Terry told me that Lt. Hayes was waiting for me and was bantering about ripping my stripes right off my shirt. Terry advised me to go into Harry Hayes' office and beg for help explaining that I had made a terrible decision and Hayes was the only one who could save me, so that is what I did. When I walked in, Hayes was ready to pounce but I got my words out first. After my *mia copa* Hayes chastised me (quite roughly I might add) then he took care of the problem. The problem all went away.

Terry's "heads up" and sound advice saved me that day (at least my career). From that day on we laughed about the time we pulled one over on Harry Hayes.

PS: We didn't really pull one over on Harry Hayes, Harry just let us think we did.

It was a great time to be a Birmingham Police.
